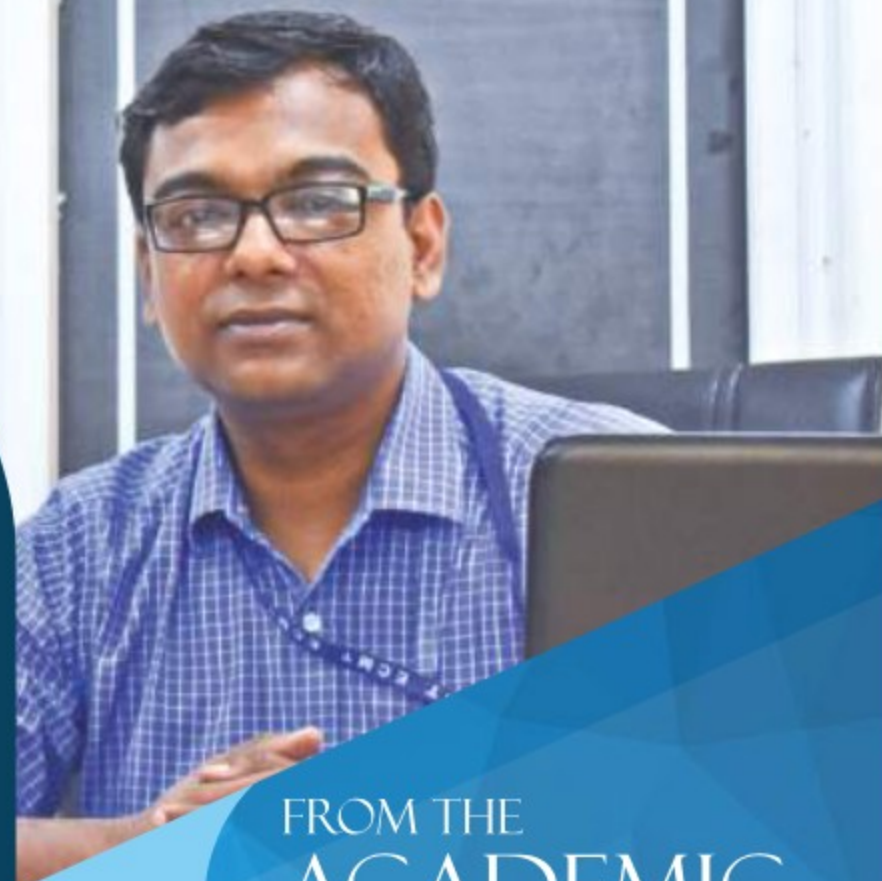

## OUR RULES AND HOSTEL

### General Rules

Everyday classes will start from 10.00 a.m. & will end at 5.30 p.m. Students have to reach college within the scheduled time & cannot leave college without prior permission.

Everyday students have to maintain their uniform properly & have wear their ID – Card during college hours; otherwise they will not be allowed to enter the college permission. 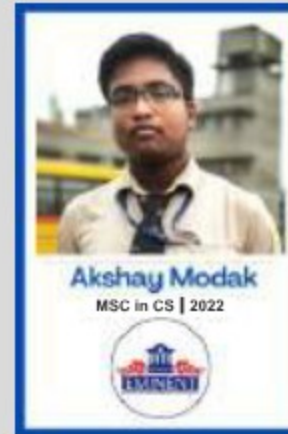

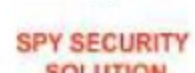
